Spotlight Interview (Q&A): Q: Can you tell us about where you were before joining DFS GNYC?

When Nishi first came to Dress for Success, she was pursuing a degree in Psychology with a Business Administration minor at Fordham University. At this time, she was balancing multiple jobs to support her family. Beneath her drive was a quiet struggle with confidence, as a person who stutters. Nishi said, "I wanted to represent women like me." She shared, "but I didn't believe I could."

Q: What motivated you to connect with Dress for Success Greater New York City?

Nishi was drawn to Dress for Success because she wanted more than just career guidance, she was looking for a sense of community and belonging. "I wanted to find a space that saw me as a whole person, not just a resume," she explained. Q: Which Dress for Success programs or experiences impacted you most?

She especially found value in:

- Success Starts Now "Boost Your Confidence and Optimizing Your Energy in the Workplace"
 Workshop, which helped her develop self awareness and communication tools.
- Women in the Workplace, which created a safe space for open dialogue and peer support.
- One on One Mentoring, where she received personalized guidance from women who walked the path before her.
- Financial Coaching, which gave her tools to budget, plan and build a stable financial foundation, something she hadn't been taught at home.

Her styling session was a defining moment. "when I put on that blazer and looked in the mirror, it was emotional," she said. "For the first time, I saw myself as the women I was becoming, not just the girl who was trying."

Since her time with Dress for Success, Nishi has stepped boldly into her professional journey. She previously worked on the Corporate Banking FinTech team at Barclays and now works at JPMorgan Chase.
